Great Lakes HamCon: The Great Lakes HamCon had a booth at the Dayton Hamvention. The hamfest will be held at Michigan International Speedway on October 7 & 8. New Business

Mark suggested at the Board Meeting that we review our emergency simplex frequencies. Currently we are using the repeater output frequency of 147.06 MHz, 146.550MHz and 147.420 MHz. The repeater output sometimes gets interference from other repeaters and is defined as a repeater frequency and not simplex. 146.55 MHz is often in use by local amateurs. Dan will get with Hillsdale County Emergency Manager Doug Sanford N8WFB to discuss options, as this will impact SKYWARN procedures.

Michigan Governor Rick Snyder proclaimed the week of June 19-25 as Amateur Radio Week in Michigan. Don read the proclamation.

Michigan State Parks on the Air event started April 1. The Michigan State Parks system as a whole will be 100 years old in 2019. Some parks actually began operation in 1917, so the event will continue through 2019.
